

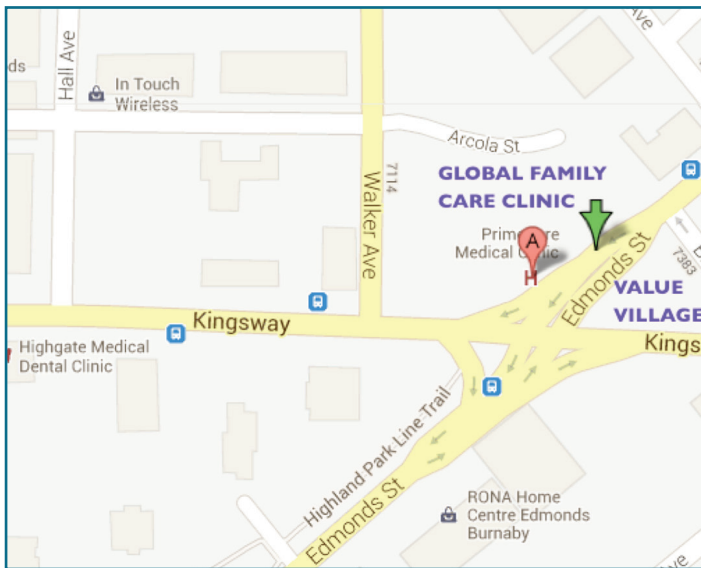

Clinic Now Open for Newcomers to Canada

At the Global Family Care Clinic (GFCC), we can help with all family health care needs for newcomers to Canada. GFCC welcomes referrals for newcomer families and individuals who do not have a regular family physician. Patients are cared for by a nurse practitioner (NP) who works with consulting physicians as needed. Newcomer patients can receive services at the clinic whether they have Interim Federal Health Program coverage or if they are awaiting MSP coverage. If interpretation is needed, a professional interpreter can be arranged. Care is available by appointment only.

- Privately sponsored refugees
- Refugee claimants



The clinic provides health care for newcomer patients including:

- Pregnant women & their families
- Mothers with newborns & their families
- Children under five years & their families

The clinic provides health care for newcomers who experience challenges including:

- Language barriers
- Barriers to understanding and navigating the health care system
